This responds to your notice of appeal dated March 4, 2014. To the extent this is an attempt to appeal this Court's order of April 18, 2012, in the above matter, no action will be taken on it by this Court. Instead, any appellate review would be to the Supreme Court of the United States, and that review would have to be sought in the manner specified by the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States. These rules are available at www.supremecourt.gov.

To the extent you may be attempting to file a motion in the above case, no action will be taken on it since the remittitur was sent in the case on May 30, 2012. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007) (sending of remittitur ends appellate jurisdiction and no further motion can be considered by the appellate court).

Finally, I note that the above post-conviction relief case involved your convictions in 1984-GS-21-0525. Your notice of appeal references a 1982-GS-21-00622. I
