

I am in receipt of the Petition for Rehearing filed by defense counsel in the above-referenced matter. As the Court is aware, the Defendant CompTrust ACG of the Carolinas is in liquidation and under the statute, there is a ninety (90) day stay of all proceedings in all courts. I would simply appreciate being advised as to whether or not the ninety (90) day stay applies to proceedings such as the Petition for Rehearing that defense counsel just filed in the Court of Appeals and, if so, should this Petition even be accepted for filing at this time.
