AND LESS THAN 15 COPIES**



Copying at the store is very expensive for him because the Record on Appeal has a total of 270 pages each.

- (2) Appellant spoke with Clerk of Court, the Honorable Jenny Abbott Kitchings on February 18, 2014 and was told that he could file 10 copies without binding because the court is now switching to the electronic filing system. A motion would be required because there is a court order on February 10, 2014 requiring him to file the Record on Appeal pursuant to SCACR.
- (3) Appellant further moves the court to allow him to file his Final Brief the same way with 10 copies to the court without color binding.


