
Dear Mr. Holmes:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, it does not show service on respondents.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the lower court order number should be part of the caption of both the notice of appeal and the proof of service.
- Per Rule 203(e)(1)(E), SCACR, the notice shall contain names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.
- Per Rule 203(e)(1)(C), SCACR, the notice shall be accompanied by the date of the order, judgment, or sentence from which the appeal is taken, and a statement of when the appealing party received notice of the order or judgment from which the appeal is taken.

Please provide an amended notice of appeal and proof of service reflecting these changes within ten (10) days or your appeal may be dismissed.
