
Dear Ms. Allen:

Please accept this letter in response to the correspondence I received from Mr. Hood, attorney for Jerry Holtzclaw. I submit the following in response to his letter.

1. Mr. Hood indicated that no certificate was attached to the Record on Appeal. I did not file a certificate because I am proceeding Pro Se and am not represented by counsel in this case and accordingly did not file a certificate of counsel.
2. He further asserts that the Record on Appeal was not covered and bound. I reviewed Rule 210 which refers to Rule 267(d) that indicates that "one copy shall be filed with the court unbound". Therefore I did not have the copies of the record on appeal bound or covered.
3. Mr. Hood suggests that the material in the Record on Appeal is out order. I submit that I followed the Court's direction as indicated in the Table of Contents of the Record and placed the documents in the correct order for filing.
4. He also asserts that portions of the transcript "not designated by inclusion" are in the Record on Appeal. I followed the instruction letter of the Court and removed the portions of the transcript that should not have been included. If any portions of the transcript were included that should not have been that was an error only. However, Mr. Hood does not indicate which section he is referring to and as such makes it difficult to respond with any specificity.
5. Finally counsel submits that the Record on Appeal "fails to include a large portion of the matter designated by the Respondent, including, substantial portions of the trial transcript and the trial exhibits. Here again, counsel does not make specific assertions (other than the trial exhibits which are referenced in the index at number 10.
