
Dear Vivian H. Cross

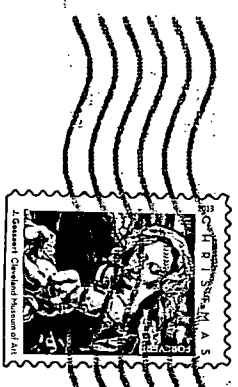
