

## ORDER

Attorney Tara Dawn Shurling has filed a motion to relieve Robert T. Williams, Sr. as counsel of record and substitute herself as counsel for Appellant. The State has not filed a return. Attorney Shurling has filed proof Appellant consents to the substitution of counsel. The motion is granted. Robert T. Williams, Sr. shall be relieved as counsel of record, and Tara Dawn Shurling shall be substituted as counsel for Appellant.
