Dear Mr. Shearouse,

I am the Appellate in the above captioned matter.
I filed the ~~prose~~ notice of appeal with this court.
I have received the letter dated March 7, 2014
addressed to Mr. Brian P. Johnson, Esquire, Counsel
for appellant. I ask the court to please allow me
to explain why I filed this notice of appeal.

As of late November 2013 I was being denied
access to the courts by SCDC staff member Mrs.
Smith whom works in the Administrative segregation
unit here at Lee County Correctional. Mrs Smith
was refusing to provide me with SCDC Form
10-14 "Agreement to Debit E. H. Cooper Account"
(see enclosed)

The form enclosed is only to be used as an example.

These forms are how and inmate purchases envelopes, pen, paper and postage. Without them I had no way to correspond with Counsel.

At this same time I received a copy of a motion to vacate Disposition and Reopen Proceedings from Counsel which he desired to file in the lower court.

In this motion I discovered for the first time that the Honorable D. Garrison Hill Administrative Judge of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit signed the Final Order on December 3, 2013 which was filed Dec. 9, 2013.

There were things in the motion, in my view, were not true, and I had to sell one of my dinner trays to obtain a "debit form" to write Counsel and the Honorable D. Garrison Hill about my concerns.

Counsel wrote me back stating that he would file the motion but never mentioned any of my concerns the motion was then filed December 13, 2013.

The Honorable D. Garrison Hill never responded at all.

I never heard from Counsel throughout the month of January 2013. I had no idea what was going on. All I knew is that my next step would be to file appeal. I did not want to miss the filing deadline so I did the only thing I thought was right.

On February 5, 2014 Counsel notified me of a hearing on the motion to take place on Feb. 21, 2014. At the hearing Counsel did not have the F.B.I. file to prove a sufficient reason exist to vacate the disposition of the Order. So the motion was then denied. Counsel then provided me with a copy of the final order.

Once I returned to SCDC I reviewed the final Order and realized that none of my issues were in the order. I have asked Counsel to file a 59(e) motion to Amend my issues in the order. This was Feb. 24 2014. I have yet to hear from Counsel. I also filed my own 59(e). Although I do not know whether I was to Amend each issue individual in the same motion or file individual motions.

For a time me and Counsel just was not able to communicate properly.

I feel that I was cheated in my first PCR

and denied appellate review. For this reason I have become extremely paranoid in my litigations.

I only want an evidentiary hearing to prove counsel was ineffective at trial which resulted in me being wrongfully convicted and punished for a crime of which I did not commit.
