Madam,

In desperate search for justice in behalf of over 670,000 SCANA / SCE&G ratepayers who were overcharged already for more than five years, I, Joseph Wojcicki, the relator of this Corporate Legal Team False Claim of SC Base Load Review Act (BLRA) am asking for your intervention.

First of all, I am surprised by the court order dated February 11, 2014 stating the denial of my petition without reasons given. Over the last four years all my petitions to intervene were denied in the Public Service Commission, including the last one in 2013 using BLRA as a legal reason. All comments were ignored and all protests from SC residents disregarded. Even simple common sense had no power to attract legal attention to this serious issue.

Ad rem:

There **will not be** enough water from the Broad River to legally (i.e. respecting rules, licenses and engineering science) cool the new reactors installed in Jenkinsville for a minimum uninterrupted 292 days in each 12-month period in each of the 60 years of expected reactors' life and operation. I have full proof of this situation in my engineering analysis. This report took countless hours I volunteered since 2009, and as already reviewed by some lawyers shall be protected by the False Claim Acts of the USA and SC Code of Laws (I believe Sections on False pretense).

For decades my knowledge and expertise were used and respected in large-scale investments in the energy industry in Europe. During the PSC hearings, I noted that the questioning in cross-examinations had disclosed numerous times an embarrassing lack of knowledge in the panel of experts.

Justice should be served here for the people and for the better future of South Carolina. Whether or not I am allowed to state my findings in the court proceedings does not change the fact that the BLRA was claimed under false pretenses, which was used to increase energy rates in order to fund the Jenkinsville project. I cannot make any accusations based on feelings here, but definitely can show objective evidence as to the false claim, whether based on malice or just engineering errors made by SCE&G. If indeed done with knowledge beforehand (and certainly I have presented a case here already for years), then let's not forget the precedent set by the Enron scandal and domino effect that followed.

SCANA/SCE&G had and still have available Obama's stimulus secured funds, exactly assigned for Nuclear Renaissance or Federal Reserve as a source, therefore restoration of justice is easy and undisputed. Note that another nuclear project in Georgia – Vogtle got on February 19, 2014 DOE secured loan of \$6.5 Billion.

Here, disrespecting God's natural laws may only bring embarrassments for a legal profession.

My hope and the hope of others is in your wisdom and the known help you have given to the victims of previous different frauds.

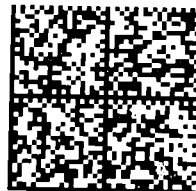

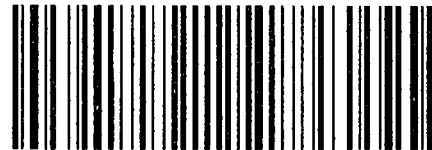
