THAT this matter resulted in a \$7,723,225.00 verdict awarded to Petitioner by a jury which was reversed by the Court of Appeals.


THAT Petitioner asserts this matter presents multiple points on which this Court should grant its Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals.
