

ORDER

The State moves to supplement the appendix in this matter and for a timeline to be established for the filing of any amendments to the petition for a writ of certiorari and the filing of the State's return to the petition. Petitioner has not filed a return to the motion. The motion to supplement the appendix is granted and the supplemental appendix is accepted as filed. Within thirty days of the date of this order, petitioner shall serve and file any amendments to the petition for a writ of certiorari currently on file with the Court, or if no amendments are to be made, provide written notification to respondent and this Court of such. The State shall have thirty days from the date of service of any amendments, or written notification that no amendments will be made, to serve and file its return to the petition for a writ of certiorari. Petitioner shall have ten days from the date of service of the return to file a reply.
