ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the South Carolina Administrative Law Court (ALC or Court) pursuant to the Notice of Appeal filed by Appellant (Inmate) above named, who is incarcerated with the South Carolina Department of Corrections (SCDC). Inmate alleges in his Notice of Appeal an exhaustive list of injuries sustained by mistreatment by SCDC staff, as well as other policy violations by staff members.

Pursuant SCDC Policy/Procedure GA-01.12, Section 7, Grievable Issues, an Inmate may file a grievance pertaining to only one (1) issue. Included within the list of permissible grievances, Section 7.2, permits an Inmate to file a grievance regarding "Actions of a staff member toward the inmate." Section 13.2 requires that a Request to Staff Member form or Grievance to be filed within five (5) days of the alleged incident.

Inmate submitted a Request To Staff Member form on December 6, 2013 and December 22, 2013. Inmate also filed a Step 1 Grievance that was received by the office of general counsel on December 31, 2013. Much of Inmate's arguments are illegible and incoherent, but it appears that Inmate asserts that he has been beaten and mistreated by SCDC for years, and he lists numerous prior appeals to the ALC, dating back to 2004, as evidence thereof. Likewise, Inmate's Notice of Appeal, filed on February 19, 2014, is simply a general statement of allegations of SCDC staff misconduct toward Inmate that does not pertain to any particular date or incident.



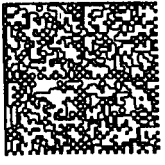

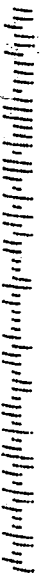
