**Motion for an Extension of Time**

DynCorp International LLC requests a fifteen (15) day extension of time to file its Petition for Rehearing in this case pursuant to Rules 221 and 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Numerous other court conflicts, deadlines, and work obligations for undersigned counsel for DynCorp prevent completion of the Petition for Rehearing within the current deadline. Specifically, undersigned counsel has (1) oral argument before this Court on April 1st, (2) depositions in Sumter County on April 3rd, (3) all day mediation on April 4th, (4) a summary judgment hearing in Oconee County on April 7th, (5) summary judgment hearings in Spartanburg County on April 8th, and (6) a summary judgment hearing in Spartanburg County on April 11th.

The time necessary to adequately prepare for those matters in addition to the time to appear for each prevent undersigned counsel from completing the Petition for Rehearing in this matter within the current deadline. An additional fifteen day extension will allow sufficient time for DynCorp to complete drafting of the Petition for Rehearing given the numerous other conflicts stated herein. This is DynCorp's first request for an extension of time. No prejudice will be caused to any party by this additional extension.

Currently, the Petition for Rehearing is due for filing on April 10, 2014. With the additional fifteen (15) day extension, the deadline would be April 25, 2014, per our calculations. DynCorp requests that the current deadline be held in abeyance while the Court considers this request.


