## ORDER

---

Respondent has filed a motion to strike portions of the record on appeal and to require Appellants to file an amended record on appeal. Respondent's motion is granted. Within thirty days of this order, Appellants will file an amended record on appeal including the matter designated by each party in its designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal *in the same form it was presented to the trial court*. See Rule 210(c), SCACR (noting the record on appeal "*shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal*" (emphasis added)). Further, Appellants are warned failure to comply with the Appellate Court Rules may result in the dismissal of their appeal. See Rule 260(a), SCACR ("Whenever it appears that an appellant or a petitioner has failed to comply with the requirements of these Rules, the clerk shall issue an order of dismissal, which shall have the same force and effect as an order of the appellate court."). Respondent shall file its final brief within twenty days after the service of the amended record on appeal.
