ORDER


Petitioner indicates that he received a copy of the final order in this post-conviction relief case on February 6, 2014. Further, he states that this copy showed it had been filed on January 27, 2014. The notice of appeal filed in this case is dated March 20, 2014.

Petitioner has not provided a proof of service showing that the notice of appeal has been served on opposing counsel as required by Rules 243(b) and 203(d)(1)(B)(i) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Further, since the notice of appeal is not even dated until after the time to serve the notice of appeal expired under Rules 243(b) and 203(b)(1), SCACR, a copy of this notice of appeal could not have been timely served on opposing counsel.

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
