THE APPELLANT HEREBY GIVES NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPEAL HIS CONVICTION OF MURDER AND POSSESSION OF WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF VIOLENT CRIME (INDICTMENT No. 2010-GS-0402635) THE APPELLANT

WAS TRIED AND CONVICTED IN THE ANDERSON COUNTY COURT OF GENERAL SESSIONS FOR THE TENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, THE HONORABLE R. LAWTON MCINTOSH WAS THE PRESIDING JUDGE. ON MARCH 18, 2014 JUDGMENT WAS ENTERED AND APPELLANT WAS GIVEN LIFE WITHOUT PAROLE FOR MURDER AND FIVE (5) YEARS FOR POSSESSION OF WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF VIOLENT CRIME TO RUN CONCURRENTLY. THE FOLLOWING ARE THE ISSUES THAT APPELLANT INTENDS TO RAISE ON DIRECT APPEAL:

- 1) THE ANDERSON COUNTY COURT OF GENERAL SESSIONS LACKED SUBJECT MATTER JURISDICTION OF THE OFFENSES CHARGED;
- 2) THE STATE LACKED PROBABLE CAUSE TO ARREST APPELLANT;
- 3) UNDULY SUGGESTIVE ELECTRONIC LINE-UP;
- 4) TRIAL JUDGE LACKED IMPARTIALITY;

- 5) THE DENIAL OF COMPULSORY PROCESS;
- 6) THE DENIAL OF SELF-REPRESENTATION, I.E. CONFLICT-FREE SELF-REPRESENTATION;
- 7) THE PROSECUTIONS KNOWING AND INTENTIONAL DESTRUCTION OF EXCULPATORY EVIDENCE;
- 8) THE PROSECUTIONS KNOWING AND INTENTIONAL SUPPRESSION OF EXCULPATORY INFORMATION AND EVIDENCE;
- 9) THE PROSECUTIONS KNOWING AND INTENTIONAL USE OF PERJURED TESTIMONY AT TRIAL;
- 10) APPELLANT WAS DENIED THE ASSISTANCE OF COUNSEL FOR THIRTEEN (13) MONTHS;
- 11) COUNSEL CONSPIRED WITH PROSECUTION BY DENYING APPELLANT PRIVATE CONSULTATION WITH REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REPUBLIC OF COSTA RICA, I.E. CONSULAR OFFICIAL;
- 12) THE DENIAL OF IMPARTIAL JURY.

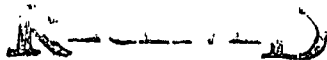
