Dear Clerk of Court:

On or about March 15, 2014, I received the copy of the enclosed letter from court reporter(s) Vivian H Cross, Ct. Rprtr. of 10th Circuit at Large / P.O. Box 704 in Belton, S.C. 29627. Vivian answered my letter(s) regarding being the "second" court reporter at my informal hearing judged by Circuit Court Judge: J. Mark Hayes II. Cross states in her letter in the second paragraph of the second sentence that, "Only one reporter sits on a hearing at a time [in Circuit Court]; however, that's not what I was informed earlier when I asked the representative(s) at Circuit Court desk(s), "who was the court reporter(s) so that I, the appellant, may obtain the necessary transcript(s)?" I was given two names: 1) Caroline Hiskell, 2) Vivian Cross. One agreed to provide transcript(s) within 60 day(s), the other denies even being present at the hearing.

Therefore, as inferred, I have appealed error(s) by Circuit Court Judge: J. Mark Hayes II, but myself, a non-lawyer of whom never went to law school(s), have made another deficiency, not on my behalf, but encumber, not as with a lien

or mortgage, but with mistake(s) after mistake(s) BECAUSE I have been given the **wrong** information by the employees of the Circuit Court/ Court of Common Pleas in Greenville, S.C..


Therefore, I still await transcript(s) by Caroline Hiskell, the official court reporter of whom did not sign, but agreed to send me 10 pages, based on the then current rate of \$3.25 per page under S.C. Rule 607 of SCACR within 60 day(s) since she received my order/request for such transcript(s). On or about April 15, 2014, as in my February 15, 2014 letter to Caroline Hiskell, as in the format she sent to me, she never disputed by mail nor phone that April 15, 2014 will be the beginning of not providing the transcript(s) to me, as her fault.

I will not mail a copy of this letter(s) to above respondent(s), especially since respondent: Michael P. Rau has abused his discretion of calling local authorities on me as "harassing" him, non-lawyer legal advisor of Tommy Joe Moore when all I did was mail him legal material after obtaining his permission to do so by him; please recall that Tommy Joe Moore said and/or implied in both Magistrate and Circuit Court that he can't read, which is why Michael P. Rau was authorized by both lower court(s) to act as his legal advisor.

Therefore, as instructed by that local city policeman of Greenville Police Department, I request to either wave responsibility(ies) OR that the Court of Appeals do send the necessary material(s) to Respondent(s) in order to prevent their potential falsehood(s) that they knew nothing of my correspondence(s),

regarding this case, with the Court of Appeals, especially since they have made it impossible to provide to them.


Dear Caroline Hiskell:


In the event I need an extension of time to complete the transcript, I will request an extension from Court Administration. You will be notified if the extension is granted.


Dear Vivian H. Cross:
