

INTELLECTUAL EVALUATION

NAME: Virginia Davis AGE: 7 yrs. 6 mos. DOB: 8/16/63

PROCEDURE: Stanford Binet L/M

REFERRAL: Virginia was referred as a candidate for special education. The teacher states that she is unable to keep up with any group in her class. She is unable to work independently. She has a short attention span and she cannot understand and carry out instructions. She plays with peers and tries to cooperate but lacks in understanding. The teacher says she has a pleasing personality, she likes to do classroom duties and she obeys cheerfully. She is described as very neat and clean.

She had a low score on the MRRT. She is in the first grade and attendance has been good.

BEHAVIOR OBSERVATIONS: In testing, Virginia is a cute, responsive, and pleasant child. She does not know her age, grade, or birthdate. Activity level is within normal limits. Effort was judged to be good.

TEST RESULTS: On the Stanford Binet, Virginia obtains a mental age of 4 yrs. 3 months. At her chronological age of 7 yrs. 6 mos., this gives her an I.Q. score of 53. This score falls in the educable range of retarded functioning.

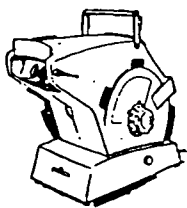
Virginia obtains credit for all items at the 3 year level, and credit for some items as high as the five year level. Low successes fall in the 3-4 year levels.

At the 5 year level, Virginia does not satisfactorily complete a picture of a man and she cannot do a simple puzzle-type item. However, she can give simple definitions and can satisfactorily draw a square.

IMPRESSIONS: A 7 year old whose intellectual functioning is currently in the educable retarded range.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Virginia qualifies for placement in a special education class for educable retarded children. She needs a program geared lower than the regular class program. Socio-cultural factors may be important in her situation. Special education may enhance her skills. She should be retested within several years to determine her then current functioning and the most appropriate placement.

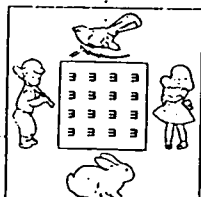

REASON FOR REFERRAL: Virginia was referred for re-evaluation and possible continuance of her special program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: She lives with her mother and has two brothers. Virginia hasn't been retained in any grade. She missed only one day last year. She has been in special classes for two years. Her grades are listed as satisfactory and her personal and social assets are listed as below normal.

BEHAVIOR DURING TESTS: Rapport was good and this examiner feels that this evaluation was a valid measure of Virginia's intellectual functioning at this time. She was very cooperative. On Picture Arrangement she showed little interest in the task.

TESTS RESULTS: WISC: Verbal 58, Performance 54, Full Scale 52. The PPVT and the DAP support the findings of the WISC. The WISC profile of scale scores are:

She is very poor in math, vocabulary, and general information. She is also weak in object assembly and picture arrangement. Her scores place her in the lower range of EMH.

TEST HISTORY: In 1971 she was given the Binet and scored 53.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Virginia should be continued in a program for EMH with emphasis in vocabulary and math. Her weakness in Picture Arrangement may be improved by arranging the pictures of comic strips. To improve Object Assembly, she should be allowed to make her on puzzles from pictures taken from mail-order catalogues.

REASON FOR REFERRAL: Virginia Davis was referred for intellectual evaluation to help determine placement in a special program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Virginia is a 13 year old black female currently enrolled in the fifth grade at Lower Lee School. There is no record of kindergarten experience. This is her sixth year of school and she has never been retained. Daily attendance is fair. Academic grades are poor. She lives at home with both parents and two siblings. Standardized data includes the following: Stanford-Binet (53) in 1971, a WISC (52) in 1974. CTBS scores (AGP 4.9) were; reading 2.9, language 2.1, math 3.3, total 2.9. Referral data notes some anti-social tendencies.

BEHAVIOR OBSERVATIONS: Rapport was fair and this examiner feels that this is a valid sampling of her intellectual functioning. She appears to be normal on height/weight factors. A review of health records indicated no significant physical problems-related to hearing, vision, orthopedic, or health factors. Affect was flat and conversational skills were poor. She has a weak voice. Her interaction with this examiner evidenced some anti-social tendencies and a low need to achieve.

TEST RESULTS: Virginia's level of intellectual functioning was placed in the mentally deficient range (56) on this administration of the Stanford-Binet. Basal was established at year six and ceiling at year eight. There were no clear interpretable patterns of strengths and weaknesses. Results of the PPVT and DAP support the findings of the Stanford-Binet. The VSMS yielded a social age of 11-1. WRAT scores were 3.9 and 2.9 on reading and arithmetic respectively.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Virginia Davis' level of intellectual functioning was placed in the mentally deficient range. This examiner recommends placement in a special class for educable retarded. She is functioning at about anticipated level and her instructional program should continue at approximately the same rate as this year. Additionally, she needs considerable assistance in value and goal setting. Even though her current prognosis is good when school achievement is considered this examiner feels that she is a high risk for failure due to the lack of goal directed behavior and an adequate repertoire of pro-social behavior.

I am an intern with Sistercare, Inc., located in Columbia, South Carolina. In that capacity, I am an advocate for your client, Ms. Virginia Burgess.




