Please with draw the "Appellants Motion For Leave Of Court In Forma Pauperis" because it is labeled or entitled for the SC Supreme Court.


There is no rules of procedure on how to procure a appeal of the SC Court Of Appeals denial of my motion to lift supersedes.

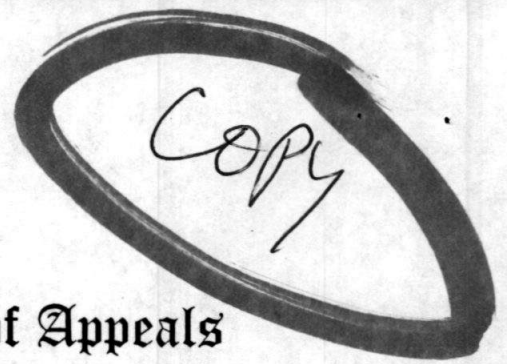

Your Motion for Leave of Court In Forma Pauperis will be filed. The State is requested to file a return to that motion within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.

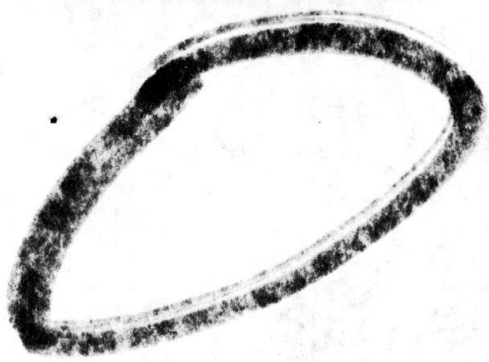

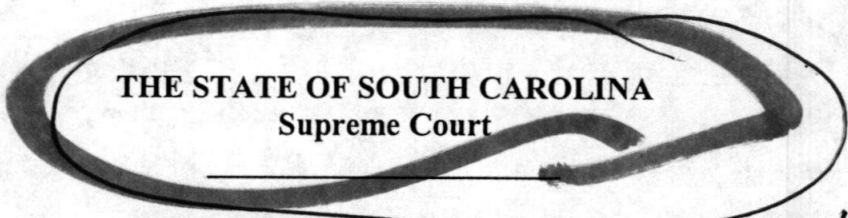
