To get their way, my attorneys will try to make me look suicidal in a way to say that the only reason I'm saying there was no promise is so that my death sentence will be upheld and can then be executed. They are mistaken. I refuse to be a part of Judge Cooper's reputation being put into question. I got to clear my ~~own~~ reputation up and I'll at least die with some integrity and honor. When I bought that gun in June 2002 I set a lot of things in motion which ended up hunting a lot of people. I changed lives in a bad way. I don't wish to delay my PER, all I'm trying to accomplish by blowing this whistle is to amend my PER application so that my motivation for pleading guilty isn't brought into question. Unrequirically, there was no promise of a life sentence in exchange for my guilty plea in March 2005. I am not suicidal. I'm only trying to do the right thing.
