AMENDED MOTION FOR COSTS ON APPEAL

The above-named Respondents, on March 26, 2014, filed and submitted with this Court a Motion for Costs on Appeal. This motion was inadvertently submitted prematurely, prior to the issuance of a Remittitur in this matter. Therefore, the Respondents submit this Amended Motion for Costs on Appeal.

The above-named Respondents hereby move this Honorable Court for an Order taxing the fees and costs set forth herein pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, against the above listed Appellant. In support of this motion, the Respondent states as follows:

1. The above captioned case was called to trial before the Honorable Kristi Harrington, Circuit Judge, in the Ninth Judicial Circuit. The above-listed Appellant was not a party to the action before the trial court and never sought to intervene in the case.

2. While observing the trial, Appellant made a “motion” before the trial court related to the case, which motion was summarily denied because Appellant was not a party.

3. Appellant appealed the denial of its “motion”. Upon motion by the Respondents, the Court of Appeals dismissed Appellant’s appeal by Order dated April 5, 2012. Appellant’s Petition for Rehearing En Banc also was denied by this Court. The South Carolina Supreme Court denied Appellant’s Petition for a Writ of Certiorari on March 19, 2014.


4. Rule 222, SCACR, permits the taxation of certain costs and fees against a party who unsuccessfully seeks a Writ of Certiorari. Accordingly, Petitioner requests this Court to Order the Appellant to be taxed with Petitioner’s costs as outlined below, in the amount permitted under the Supreme Court Order dated July 24, 1997.



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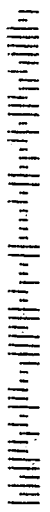
