ORDER

This appeal was previously dismissed due to Appellant's failure to serve and file the record on appeal. Appellant filed a petition to reinstate along with a deficient record on appeal. This court gave Appellant ten days to serve and file an amended record on appeal that cured the deficiencies. Appellant has now filed an amended record on appeal and a motion to "file [the] record on appeal as submitted" and to file his final brief "without color binding and less than 15 copies." After careful consideration, the petition to reinstate is granted. Furthermore, as to Appellant's motion regarding the record on appeal, Appellant is permitted to file only eleven copies. As to Appellant's motion regarding his final brief, Appellant is permitted to file it without color binding and he may file only ten copies.
