

## ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* and a motion to appoint counsel. The motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order. Furthermore, Appellant's motion to appoint counsel is denied. See *Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 310 S.C. 440 (Ct. App. 1983) (noting there is no right to an attorney in a civil case).
