
I am writing to follow up on the March 14, 2014, deficiency letter from our clerk's office.

In that letter the court identified instances in which the record on appeal and the supplemental record on appeal did not comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. Any deficiency must be corrected within **ten** days of the date of this letter or your appeal may be dismissed:

- The record on appeal is not accompanied by certificate of counsel as required by Rule 210, SCACR.
- The supplemental record on appeal is not accompanied by the required certificate of counsel.
- The cover of the supplemental record on appeal must meet the requirements of Rule 267, SCACR. The lower court information is required, and all counsel of record must be named on the cover.
- The supplemental record on appeal must have an index.

- The supplemental record on appeal is improperly paginated. Specifically, the pages are not numbered.
