TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF





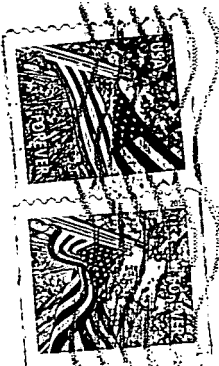
