The deceased exited the apartment and while on the porch confronted the above named defendant .Multiple shots were discharged, and a witness looking out of a window observed the defendant standing in a well lit area in possession of a firearm. The above is true and believable based on the observations of a witness that was looking out of the window at the time of the incident and the witness knows the defendant by sight and name.
