
Dear Mr. Nabors:

This responds to your *pro se* motion for injunctive relief dated April 18, 2014. Since you are represented by counsel in this matter, no action will be taken on this *pro se* motion. *Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010); *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002); *State v. Stuckey*, 333 S.C. 56, 508 S.E.2d 564 (1998); *Foster v. State*, 298 S.C. 306, 379 S.E.2d 907 (1989). Instead, if it is appropriate to seek relief of this nature in this case, that request will have to be filed by your counsel.

I am providing the Office of General Counsel with a copy of this letter so it will be aware that the above post-conviction relief case is currently pending before this Court for appellate review, and that the Division of Appellate Defense is representing you in this matter. I also call their attention to the language in your motion where you state that you are afraid that "something is going to snap inside

of me" and "that such event may lead to serious consequences beyond my control."
