
Dear Mr. Harris:

I am writing to follow up on the March 11, 2014, deficiency letter from our Clerk's office.

In that letter the court identified instances in which the motion to proceed in forma pauperis did not comply with the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. We have already given you ten days to make the corrections. We have determined that this deficiency is serious enough that we may not consider the motion if it is not corrected within **ten** days. The deficiency we previously listed was:

- A proof of service has not been provided stating the motion to proceed in forma pauperis has been filed. The proof of service received by the Court indicates the notice of appeal as served. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
