
MOTION TO HOLD TIME LIMITS IN ABEYANCE

Appellant’s initial reply brief is due to be served and filed on April 24, 2014. Appellant moves to hold in abeyance the time limits for serving and filing its initial reply brief. Undersigned counsel has consulted with Respondent's counsel, Frank Potts, and he consents to this motion. The grounds for this motion are set forth below.

Respondent has moved to amend its initial respondent's brief and designation of matter to be included in the Record on Appeal so as to eliminate designations of matter that was never presented to the trial court and amend its brief accordingly. See Rule 210(c), SCACR (record "shall not" include matter not presented to the lower court). Appellant intends to file a return that consents to the motion, but Appellant believes that at least one additional amendment is necessary. Appellant also believes the parties will be able to reach an agreement regarding any additional amendments to Respondent's brief and designation.

Therefore, with the consent of Respondent, Appellant moves to hold in abeyance the time limits for serving and filing Appellant's initial reply brief until ten (10) days after the Respondent serves and files its amended respondent's brief and designation.
