ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondents' motion to dismiss is denied at this time. However, this court notes that several deficiencies exist with the record on appeal and Appellant's final brief. Appellant must cure the following deficiencies within twenty days.

For the record on appeal:

1. The record on appeal must include all matters designated by both parties for inclusion in the record on appeal pursuant to the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). The record on appeal may not include matters not designated by either party.
2. The document is not accompanied by a certificate of counsel required by Rule 210(g), SCACR.
3. A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR.
4. Rule 210(e), SCACR, requires the record on appeal to have an index.
5. The number of copies provided is not in compliance with the SCACR. Please provide fourteen copies.

For Appellant's final brief:

1. The number of copies provided is not in compliance with the SCACR. Please provide 14 copies.
2. The document is not accompanied by certificate of counsel as required by Rule 211, SCACR.
3. A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR.
4. The cover is incorrect. The certificate of counsel cannot be the cover of the final brief. See Rule 267, SCACR.

Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal and final brief within twenty days. Respondents' final brief shall be due twenty days after the service of the amended record on appeal.
