



**ORDER DENYING APPLICANT'S MOTION  
TO ALTER TO RECONSIDER**

This matter comes before this Court by way of an application for post-conviction relief filed August May 10, 2010. In its Return, Respondent requested that the action be summarily dismissed. A Conditional Order of Dismissal was issued on December 5, 2012, and filed December 11, 2012. Applicant was served with the Conditional Order of Dismissal on January 28, 2013. Applicant responded to the Conditional Order of Dismissal, and after reviewing these responses, this Court issued a Final Order of Dismissal on May 16, 2013, filed on June 10, 2013<sup>2</sup>. Thereafter, Applicant submitted a "Notice to Show Cause to Objection to Final Order of Dismissal," which was filed on August 13, 2013. This Court interprets Applicant's "Notice to Show Cause" as a Motion to Reconsider its final Order of Dismissal. Having carefully reviewed the entire record in this matter, this Court finds that no basis for altering, amending, or reconsidering its prior ruling.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, this Court hereby denies the Applicant's Motion in its entirety, and affirms the previous Final Order of Dismissal.

This Court advises that if the Applicant desires to secure appellate review of this Order and the Final Order of Dismissal, a notice of appeal must be filed and served within thirty days of the service of

<sup>2</sup> Respondent was not served with this Final Order of Dismissal until August 22, 2013, at which time it was served upon Applicant by Respondent.  
<sup>3</sup> The Court, in its discretion, has considered this matter based upon the motions submitted by the parties and the post-conviction relief file, since oral argument will not aid the Court in reaching its decision. See Rule 59(f), SCRCP.

this Order. Applicant is directed to Rules 203, 206, and 243 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules for the appropriate procedures to follow after notice of appeal has been timely filed.


