
MOTION TO PERMIT LATE FILING



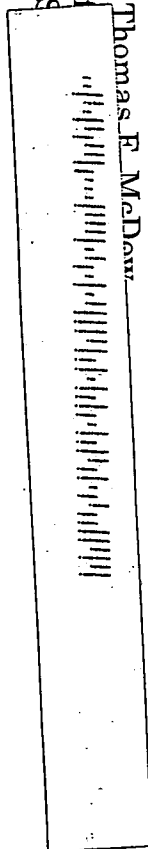

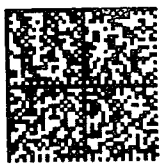
