

**APPELLANT'S SECOND MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION
TO ORDER TRANSCRIPT OF PROCEEDING**

Pursuant to the order of the Supreme Court of South Carolina dated March 18, 2009, Appellant Mikel R. Hurt moves the Court for a second extension of time to order the transcript of the proceeding, which is currently due May 5, 2014. Counsel for Appellant submits this motion upon information and belief that there is good cause to request an extension. Appellant's initial request for an extension was for the purpose of continuing discussions with the South Carolina Commission on Indigent Defense, Division of Appellate Defense (hereinafter, the "Commission") regarding representation. 
