The defendant did enter the victim's (Amanda Mitchell) apartment without permisson during nighttime hours with the intent to commit a crime. That after forced entry to a door the defendant did remove numerous items of value that belonged to the victim, which included the keys to her 2012 Hyundai Sonata (SC P441920). The defendant was witnessed to walk from the victim's apartment breezeway and use her vehicle door lock fab to unlock the doors. The defendant was then witnessed walking from the vehicle only to drive back a short time later and enter the victims vehicle. The defendant was then observed by a second witness rummaging through said vehicle. The defendant then exited the vehicle returned the keys to the victims apartment before fleeing in a 2004 Chevy Cavalier (SC4695EM) driven by the co-defendant. The defendant and co-defendant were subsequently stopped and detained fleeing the scene a short time and distance later. At the traffic stop the defendant was positively identified by both witnesses as being inside the victims vehicle. All the above items were found inside the vehicle search incident to arrest.

That all of the above is true and believable based on the observation of witnesses, Warren Johnson and Jeremy Jacobs, Ofc. Piech and investigation of Det. Feeters of the Charleston Police Department.
