STATEMENT OF THE CASE

September 3, 2013, Appellant filed a motion to reinstate this appeal, which was dismissed for failure to pay the notice of appeal filing fee August 16, 2013.

September 12, 2013, the remittitur was sent to the lower court.

November 8, 2013, the South Carolina Court of Appeals issued an order granting Appellant's motion to reinstate the appeal, and proceed without costs.

November 21, 2013, Appellant served his pro se brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal, along with proof of service in the above referenced case.

December 19, 2013, the clerk of South Carolina Court of Appeals informed Appellant that each item be clearly identified in the designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

And that the documents which are each identified in Appellant's

November 21, 2013, filings will be included in the record on appeal.

January 9, 2014, Respondent filed a Initial Brief of Respondent and designation of matter in referenced to above case.

January 23, 2014, the clerk of South Carolina Court of Appeals informed Respondent a motion to allow the late filing will have to be made.

January 27, 2014, Respondent filed the motion.

February 6, 2014, Appellant filed a reply in response to Respondent's Initial Brief of Respondent's and designation of matter.

FEBRUARY 7, 2014, THE SOUTH CAROLINA COURT OF APPEALS ISSUED AN ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO FILE LATE THE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER OUT OF TIME.

FEBRUARY 24, 2014, THE DEPUTY CLERK OF COURT INFORMED APPELLANT THAT A MOTION TO ALLOW THE LATE FILING OF THE REPLY IN RESPONSE TO RESPONDENT'S INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER.

MARCH 5, 2014, APPELLANT MOTION TO ACCEPT LATE FILING WAS FILED WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA COURT OF APPEALS.

MARCH 14, 2014, THE SOUTH CAROLINA COURT OF APPEALS DEPUTY CLERK ISSUED A ORDER GRANTING APPELLANT'S MOTION TO FILE LATE THE INITIAL REPLY BRIEF.


REINSTATEMENT
