MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Michael Maxwell respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until June 5, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Dusty A. Cyr with the Court of Appeals on March 21, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Adarius Q. Dennis v. State of South Carolina with this Court on March 20, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Shawn J. Burris with the Court of Appeals on March 13, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Chavis L. Cox v. State of South Carolina with this Court on March 4, 2014. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




