Appellants' counsel have filed a motion to be relieved as counsel. Counsel served Appellants with the motion, but Appellants did not file a response. Appellants Pyxis Financial Group, LLC, and Carina Wealth Management, LLC, have thirty days to retain new counsel. *See Renaissance Enterprises, Inc. v. Summit Teleservices*, 334 S.C. 649, 515 S.E.2d 257 (1999) (holding an attorney must represent a corporation in circuit or appellate courts). Appellant Jason A. Schall has thirty days to obtain new counsel or inform this Court he intends to proceed pro se. Appellants shall also provide this court with a status update regarding Appellant Schall's bankruptcy case within thirty days.
