ORDER INFORMATION

Before the court is Defendant's Motion to Alter or Amend Judgment filed March 20, 2014 pursuant to Rule 59, SCRPC. Defendant's Motion is DENIED; however, the order of the Court filed March 14, 2014 is clarified as follows:

Having fully reviewed the pleadings in the file, Defendant's affidavit, and the oral arguments of counsel in a light most favorable to the Defendant, this court finds that summary judgment is proper at this stage. Defendant's affidavit merely presents her own conclusion that the amount owed to Plaintiff is unreasonable; however, the Defendant has failed to present specific facts made by an independent witness or otherwise to support her allegation. Rule 56, SCRPC; see *Coker v. Cummings*, 381 S.C. 45, 55, 671 S.E.2d 383, 388 (Ct. App. 2008) (affirming grant of summary judgment where non-moving party's affidavit in opposition was purely speculative and failed to raise a material question of fact). Accordingly, there is no dispute of material facts in this case, and Plaintiff's Motion is GRANTED.
