ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from a memorandum of the Administrative Law Court Clerk's Office, which indicates his documents are being returned to him and his appeal will not be processed until it is accompanied by an appropriate filing fee. Because this clerk's office memorandum is not a final order, this appeal is dismissed. *See* Rule 201(a), SCACR ("Appeal may be taken, as provided by law from any *final* judgment, appealable order or decision."
