



Yes. If an appeal is filed, you may ask for a free copy of the tape recording of the hearing. A written transcript of the hearing may be provided at a fee of not more than sixty-five cents (65¢) per page or sixty-five dollars (\$65) per transcript, whichever is less. A free copy of the transcript may be provided if you submit a sworn statement (notarized by a notary public) asking for a copy and saying that you cannot afford to pay for a copy.

Where can I get a copy of the law, regulations and this pamphlet?

If the decision is unfavorable to me, why should I read my appeal rights?

Following a hearing, the hearing official issues a decision regarding a claimant's qualification or eligibility to receive benefits under Unemployment Insurance (UI) and other programs administered by DES, overpayment of benefits to a claimant, or the charging or non-charging of UI benefits to an employer's account. The decision includes an explanation of your right to appeal. It sets forth the deadline for filing the appeal. If filed untimely, the appeal may be denied unless you can show good cause or excusable neglect for the appeal deadline to be extended.

What should I say in my appeal about the decision on the hearing issues and any other issues for which the parties waived written notice?

An appeal must be written. DES local offices have forms that may be used for filing appeals. You must state your desire to appeal and the specific reasons why you disagree with the decision or any defects in the hearing process that occurred before the decision was issued. You must include the claimant's social security number and the docket number of the decision, and sign and date the appeal. If you are the employer, you should also include the name of your business and the name and title of the individual filing the appeal on your behalf. **NOTE:** If you just state "I appeal" or "I disagree with the decision" or do not address the contents of the decision or the hearing process, your appeal will be dismissed.

1. BORROWER'S PROMISE TO PAY

In return for a loan that I have received, I promise to pay U. S. \$ 99,900.00 (this amount is called "principal"), plus interest, to the order of the Lender. The Lender is FIRST UNION MORTGAGE CORPORATION. I understand that the Lender may transfer this Note. 2. INTEREST

I may make a full prepayment or partial prepayments without paying any prepayment charge. The Note Holder will use all of my prepayments to reduce the amount of principal that I owe under this Note.
