

Dear Judges Few, Cureton and Ms. Kitchings and parties,

My wife, the pro se appellant/respondent/party who prevailed in the jury trial in Greenville County jury trial of three days duration in 2009, is out of town and imminently out of the country, and I note there is a small envelope mailed to our residence addressed to her. She is not to return until mid-June. I know personally she has diligently met each and every one of your deadlines for several years and at great expense to our family. I have too been wrapped up unjustly in this matter at great expense, embarrassment, and time even though I was never a member of Blue Ridge Coop, which they knowingly and wrongly advised several Courts but admitted to *under examination* during the above referenced trial. They even refused to talk to me if we had power outage issues that were frequent. We just want the support pole that serves no one, wrongly placed on my wife's property on scenic highway 11, removed and the area returned to its clean state as it long existed in excess of 25 years. It is not fair to take property and then further to refuse to maintain it, and then proceed to harass an excellent Blue Ridge customer of decades as is my wife and as Blue Ridge finally admitted under oath at trial. She has been treated most unfairly and in a discriminatory fashion by Blue Ridge Electric. With my wife's medical issues of which she has kindly reminded you and my own that were made clear as well, not to mention, issues of our only remaining son, we have bent over backwards to comply and perform for you despite having long ago prevailed in a three-day jury trial after an approximate two year anguishing wait for justice. It is tragic still about 7 years later, we are still being harassed by Blue Ridge, apparently without sanctions by the Court. We are owed an apology.

We cannot respond further and my wife has not even seen whatever you/others have sent to our home. I know you have her briefs, for I saw them dispatched to you, and know from personal knowledge, they compiled with the timetable dictated in the appeal by Judge Few, while Blue Ridge did not so comply. She is diligent, respectful, and not deserving of any blame for this travesty. I have been amazed at this process as I believe most citizens and legislators of S.C. would be as well. Move the trespassing, offending pole. You have lessened the quality of our life in this nightmare of legal entanglement.

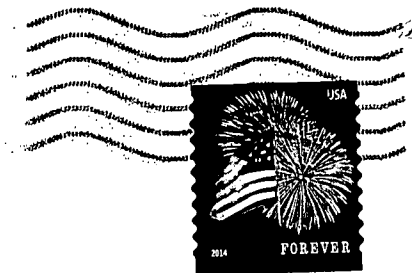

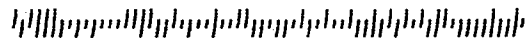
