
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I now write to you to provide a status update per the request of this Court on this appeal. As you will recall, we are currently awaiting the delivery of the transcript from the reconstruction hearing held in January of this year. Although we have received confirmation from the court reporter that she received our second request for a transcript (after she informed Court Administration she never received the first request), the second 60-day time frame allotted to the Court Reporter by the Appellate Court Rules has yet to expire.
