On behalf of Respondent Nexsen Pruet LLC, I am writing to request a 30-day extension of time to file Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. This is Respondent's second request for an extension.

Respondent is seeking an extension of time because on May 6, 2014, Respondent filed a Motion to Strike Documents in Designation of Matter and to Require Appellants to File Amended Brief, which is currently pending before the Court, and in that motion, Respondent asked the Court to stay the deadline to file its initial brief and designation of matter pending a ruling on the motion. Respondent requested a stay because the Court's ruling on the motion may impact the content of Respondent's brief.

Because the Court may not decide the motion to strike before the deadline for Respondent to file its initial brief, Respondent requests a 30-day extension.


Appellants consent to the 30-day extension but oppose Respondent's motion to strike, including Respondent's request to stay the deadline to file its initial brief and designation of matter pending a ruling on the motion.

Respondent's initial brief and designation of matter are currently due Wednesday, May 21, 2014. If the request for an extension is granted, the initial brief and designation of matter will be due Friday, June 20, 2014.
