**ORDER COMPELLING SCDC TO
FULLY RESPOND TO PLAINTIFFS'
9TH INTERROGATORY 2 AND PLAINTIFFS
TO FULLY RESPOND TO SCDC'S 3RD
INTERROGATORY 9**

This Order addresses pending cross motions to compel with respect to two related interrogatories.

Plaintiffs 9th Interrogatory 2

Plaintiffs' 9th Interrogatory 2, served July 28, 2008, seeks "the last known address, date of birth, and social security number of every SCDC employee and former employee deposed in this action" as well as five former SCDC employees not deposed. In response, SCDC provided on October 8, 2009 last known addresses for the five non-deponents, but no other information.

This interrogatory has been the subject of two motions to compel by Plaintiffs and one motion for sanctions. SCDC has already been ordered to provide a complete response to this interrogatory in two separate orders, the Amended Scheduling Order of June 10, 2009 and the Order Denying Plaintiffs' Motion for Sanctions dated June 10, 2010.

SCDC's 3rd Interrogatory 29


On June 7, 2010, SCDC served its 3rd Interrogatory 29, asking Plaintiffs to identify all former SCDC employees it had contacted. Plaintiffs objected, based on SCDC's failure to provide an adequate response to Plaintiffs' 9th Interrogatory 2.

ORDER

SCDC is hereby ordered to fully respond to Plaintiffs' 9th Interrogatory 2, by providing Plaintiffs with the last known addresses, dates of birth, and social security numbers for all present and former SCDC employees who have been deposed in this case, as well as for the five individuals specifically listed in the interrogatory. SCDC is ordered to provide this information within fifteen (15) days of this Order.

Plaintiffs are ordered to fully respond to SCDC's 3rd Interrogatory 29 within fifteen (15) days of SCDC's response.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
