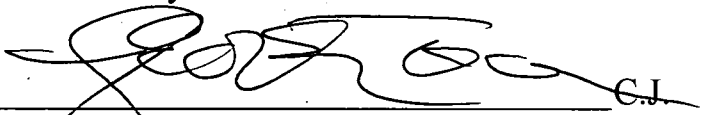

ORDER

Alexis K.
