
WHEREFORE, respondent respectfully requests that this Honorable Court ORDER appellant to supplement the Record on Appeal with the above listed materials.



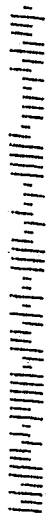

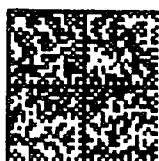
