MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME



Jake Antonio Wilson in this Court on May 8, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Bruce Wilson v. State of South Carolina with this Court on May 7, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Rudolph Israel Edwards with the Court of Appeals on April 30, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Andrew James Harrelson with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty day extension, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the petition be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


