

ORDER

Appellant asks this Court to seal three items included in their Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal (DOM). In addition, they ask that the documents be sealed from the view of respondent and his counsel.

The Record on Appeal is due on May 27, 2014. In order to maintain the expedited nature of the appeal and allow respondent an opportunity to respond to appellant's motion to seal, respondent is directed to serve and file its DOM on May 27, 2014, with Items (11), (12), and (13) filed under seal and not included in the copy served on respondent. Respondent shall serve and file a return to the motion to seal by May 29, 2014. Once the Court has ruled on the motion to seal, the parties will be directed as to whether the materials will remain sealed.
