
I am writing to follow up on the April 3, 2014, deficiency letter from our Clerk's office.

In that letter the court identified instances in which second amended notice of appeal, did not comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). We have determined that those deficiencies are serious enough that we must dismiss the appeal if they are not corrected. We have already given you ten days to make the corrections. If you fail to correct these deficiencies within **ten** days of the date of this letter, your appeal will be dismissed. The deficiencies previously identified were:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must be in the format of the lower court order dated March 10, 2014.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The proof of service is not dated.

- Counsel for the respondent, Caroline Richardson Glenn, was not served.
