I have received your letter hand-dated June 8th, postmarked June 18th, 2012, inquiring whether or not I still have audio-tapes for the above-captioned trial.

Rule 607 provides, in part, that in any proceeding which has been transcribed, the court reporter shall retain audio tapes for a period of at least thirty (30) days after the transcript is sent to the requesting party to allow any party to challenge the accuracy of the transcription. If no challenge is received by the court reporter within the thirty (30) day period, the tapes may be reused or destroyed.
